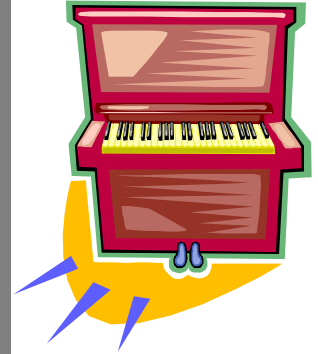




Make a Difference for a Youth Today !!!

The ACCHORD Music Mentorship Program involves volunteer musicians providing free guitar, bass and piano lessons to youth ages 11-17 at Looking Glass Station 7 Teen Shelter. Once a teen has completed 10 lessons, they receive a free instrument. This Program is a raging success. Established in early 2000, ACCHORD volunteers have provided hundreds of free lessons to teens, and have given instruments to 15 teens.

Teens at Station 7 have experienced much hardship. By learning to accomplish something on an instrument, they build self-esteem and confidence. Many of these youth have never had the opportunity to even touch an instrument, much less receive individualized instruction.
